Section 503.0633(f), Transportation Code, 5 as 6 effective July 1, 2025, is amended to read as follows: the department determines that a 7 (f) dealer is If 8 fraudulently obtaining license plates or sets of license plates or 9 fraudulently using the database of dealer-issued license plates, or 10 has been denied access to the temporary tag database under former Section 503.0632(f), the department may, after giving notice 11 12 electronically and by certified mail to the dealer, deny access to 13 the database of dealer-issued license plates to the dealer. А dealer denied access to the database of dealer-issued license 14 plates under this subsection may request a hearing on the denial as 15 provided by Subchapter O, Chapter 2301, Occupations Code. 16 SECTION 2. Section 17 504.901, Transportation Code, as effective July 1, 2025, is amended to read as follows: 18

19 Sec. 504.901. <u>REMOVAL AND</u> TRANSFER OF LICENSE PLATES. (a) 20 On the sale or transfer of a motor vehicle to a dealer who holds a 21 general distinguishing number issued under Chapter 503, the dealer 22 shall remove each license plate issued for the motor vehicle. <u>The</u> 23 <u>dealer shall transfer each removed license plate to a motor vehicle</u> 24 <u>if that motor vehicle is purchased from the dealer and the license</u>

1 plates are appropriate for the class of vehicle to which the plates
2 are being transferred [Each license plate issued for the motor
3 vehicle shall be assigned to a subsequent purchaser of the motor
4 vehicle at retail sale as required by Section 503.063].

5 (b) On the sale or transfer of a motor vehicle to a person 6 who does not hold a general distinguishing number issued under 7 Chapter 503, <u>the seller shall remove</u> each license plate issued for 8 the motor vehicle. <u>The removed license plates may be transferred to</u> 9 <u>another vehicle titled in the seller's name if the license plates</u> 10 <u>are appropriate for the class of vehicle to which the plates are</u> 11 <u>being transferred and the seller obtains:</u>

12 (1) the department's approval of an application to 13 transfer the license plates; and

14 (2) a new registration insignia for [shall remain 15 with] the motor vehicle.

16 (c) A license plate removed from [(b-1) The purchaser of] a 17 motor vehicle that is not transferred to another motor vehicle must 18 be disposed of in a manner prescribed by the department not later 19 than the 10th day after the date the license plate is removed from 20 the motor vehicle [may request replacement license plates under 21 Section 504.007].

22 SECTION 3. Not later than October 1, 2025, the Texas 23 Department of Motor Vehicles shall adopt rules as necessary to 24 implement or administer the changes in law made by this Act.

25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 2025, if this Act 26 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each 27 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
