A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Article 56B.054(f), Code of Criminal Procedure
7 is amended to read as follows:

8 Art. 56B.054(f) On request by the attorney general and not later
9 than the 14th business day after the date of the request, a law
10 enforcement agency shall release to the attorney general all
11 reports, including witness statements and criminal history record
12 information, to allow the attorney general to determine whether a
13 claimant or victim qualifies for an award and the extent of the
14 qualification. Information received by the attorney general under
15 this subsection is not subject to release under Texas Government
16 Code Chapter 552.

17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
