1 (b-1) A person is a qualified petitioner under Subsection 2 (b-2) if the person: (1) is employed in a management position responsible 3 for overseeing the operations of a hotel, including: 4 5 (A) the owner or general manager of a hotel; 6 (B) a regional manager who oversees the 7 operations of a hotel; or 8 (C) an employee of a management company who 9 oversees the operation of a hotel; and (2) provides a written statement that the person is 10 authorized to enter into a binding agreement concerning the 11 operation of a hotel on behalf of the owner of a hotel. 12 13 (b-2) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), a petition for the establishment of a public improvement district described by Section 14 372.0035(a-1) [$\frac{372.0035(a)}{a}$ or $\frac{(a-1)}{a}$] is sufficient only if the 15 16 petition is: 17 (1) signed by qualified petitioners who represent [record owners of taxable real property liable for assessment under 18 the proposal who constitute: 19 $[\frac{1}{1}]$ more than 60 percent of the appraised value of 20 hotel [taxable real] property liable for assessment under the 21 proposal, as determined by the current roll of the appraisal 22 district in which the property is located, [+] and who: 23 [(2) more than 60 percent of: 24

- 7 SECTION 4. Sections 372.0035(a) and (e-1), Local Government

- 11 establishment or renewal of a public improvement district filed on
- 12 or after the effective date of this Act. A petition filed before
- 13 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on
- 14 the date the petition is filed, and the former law is continued in
- 15 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
