A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the authority of a political subdivision to regulate
3	fire prevention standards for certain agricultural facilities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 250, Local Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 250.014 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 250.014. RESTRICTION ON REGULATION OF CERTAIN
8	AGRICULTURAL FACILITIES. (a) In this section:
9	(1) "Agricultural pole barn" means a nonresidential
10	farm building in which 70 percent or more of the perimeter walls are
11	permanently open and allow free ingress and egress.
12	(2) "Nonresidential farm building" means any
13	temporary or permanent building on a farm, ranch, or other
14	agricultural facility that is used primarily for agricultural
15	purposes and not intended to be used as a residential dwelling. The
16	term includes a barn, greenhouse, shade house, farm office, storage
17	building, workshop, poultry house, animal handling facility, or
18	commodity storage and feed processing facility.
19	(b) Notwithstanding any other law, a political subdivision
20	may not adopt or enforce an ordinance, order, or other measure that
21	requires the installation of a fire protection sprinkler system in:
22	(1) an agricultural pole barn;
23	(2) a nonresidential farm building;
24	(3) a cotton gin;

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- 1 (4) a livestock market, as that term is defined by
- 2 <u>Section 161.111</u>, Agriculture Code; or
- 3 <u>(5) a commercial feed mill.</u>
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
