## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to the eligibility of a person to serve on a civilian 3 oversight board.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 143.003, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subdivision (1) and adding Subdivision (1-a) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (1) "Civilian oversight board" means a board or office
- 9 <u>established by a municipality to practice oversight, monitoring, or</u>
- 10 <u>investigations of fire fighters or police officers, or departments,</u>
- 11 by members of the public who are not fire fighters or police
- 12 <u>officers.</u>

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- 13 (1-a) "Commission" means the Fire Fighters' and Police
- 14 Officers' Civil Service Commission.
- 15 SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 143, Local Government
- 16 Code, is amended by adding Section 143.091 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 143.091. ELIGIBILITY FOR CIVILIAN OVERSIGHT BOARD. A
- 18 person is not eligible to serve on a civilian oversight board if the
- 19 person has been:
- 20 <u>(1) convicted of or placed on deferred adjudication</u>
- 21 community supervision for a felony offense; or
- 22 (2) convicted of a crime of moral turpitude.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
