(a) In this section: 8 (1) "Medical school" has the meaning assigned by 9 10 Section 61.501(1), except that the term also includes the school of osteopathic medicine at the University of the Incarnate Word. 11 (2) "Pediatric subspecialty" means a pediatric 12 13 medical subspecialty certification offered by a member board of the American Board of Medical Specialties or American Osteopathic 14 15 Association. (b) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board may 16 17 contract with one or more organizations to operate a statewide pediatric subspecialty preceptorship program for medical students 18 enrolled in Texas medical schools. 19 (c) An organization eligible to receive funds under this 20 section must: 21 22 (1) qualify for exemption from federal income tax

- 1 (2) be operated by a state accredited medical school.
- 2 (d) Students eligible to participate in the preceptorship
- 3 program under this section must indicate an interest in a career in
- 4 a pediatric subspecialty.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 6 academic year.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
