- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 58, Education Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 58.011 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 58.011. STATEWIDE PEDIATRIC SUBSPECIALTY
- 8 PRECEPTORSHIP PROGRAM. (a) In this section:
- 9 <u>(1) "Medical school" has the meaning assigned by</u>
- 10 Section 61.501(1), except that the term also includes the school of
- 11 osteopathic medicine at the University of the Incarnate Word.
- 12 (2) "Pediatric subspecialty" means a pediatric
- 13 medical subspecialty certification offered by a member board of the
- 14 American Board of Medical Specialties or American Osteopathic
- 15 Association.
- 16 (b) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board may
- 17 contract with one or more organizations to operate a statewide
- 18 pediatric subspecialty preceptorship program for medical students
- 19 enrolled in Texas medical schools.
- 20 <u>(c) An organization eligible to receive funds under this</u>
- 21 <u>section must:</u>
- 22 (1) qualify for exemption from federal income tax
- 23 under Section 501, Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (26 U.S.C. Section
- 24 501); or

- 1 (2) be operated by a state accredited medical school.
- 2 (d) Students eligible to participate in the preceptorship
- 3 program under this section must indicate an interest in a career in
- 4 <u>a pediatric subspecialty.</u>
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 6 academic year.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
