- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 140, Local Government Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 140.014 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 140.014. PROHIBITION ON GUARANTEED INCOME PROGRAM.
- 8 (a) In this section, "guaranteed income program" means direct or
- 9 indirect financial assistance to an individual, including cash
- 10 payments, gift cards, or equivalent monetary transfers, whether
- 11 recurring or structured as separate distributions.
- 12 (b) Unless explicitly authorized by federal law, a
- 13 political subdivision may not adopt or enforce an ordinance, order,
- 14 regulation, or other measure that establishes or provides for the
- 15 operation of a guaranteed income program for individuals.
- 16 (c) If explicitly authorized by federal law, state and local
- 17 public funds may not be used to fund, administer, or support the
- 18 operation of the guaranteed income program in any capacity.
- 19 <u>(d)</u> This section does not apply to a short-term program that
- 20 is limited in duration and nonrenewable under which an individual
- 21 is required to seek employment, perform work, or attend meaningful
- 22 and verifiable career or job trainings as a condition for receiving
- 23 a payment.
- 24 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding Section 140.014, Local

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- 1 Government Code, as added by this Act, an ordinance, order,
- 2 regulation, or other measure that establishes or provides for the
- 3 operation of a guaranteed income program, as defined by that
- 4 section, in effect before the effective date of this Act may be
- 5 enforced until the earlier of January 1, 2026, or the expiration of
- 6 the ordinance, order, regulation, or other measure.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
