- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 264.107(c), Family Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:
- r read as refress.
- 8 (c) In selecting a placement for a child, the department
- 9 shall consider whether the placement is in the child's best
- 10 interest. In determining whether a placement is in a child's best
- 11 interest, the department shall consider whether the placement:
- 12 (1) is the least restrictive setting for the child;
- 13 (2) is the closest in geographic proximity to the
- 14 child's home;
- 15 (3) is the most able to meet the identified needs of
- 16 the child; [and]
- 17 (4) satisfies any expressed interests of the child
- 18 relating to placement, when developmentally appropriate; and
- 19 <u>(5) is able to meet the long-term needs of the child,</u>
- 20 including placement stability.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
