Section 264.107, Family Code, is amended by adding Subsection (a) and amending Subsection (c) to read as follows: (a) Before placing a child in contract residential care, the department shall attempt to place the child with a relative or other designated caregiver as required by Section 262.114(d). (c) In selecting a contract residential placement for a child, the department shall consider whether the placement is in the child's best interest. In determining whether a placement is in a child's best interest, the department shall consider whether the placement: is the least restrictive setting for the child; (1)is the closest in geographic proximity to the (2) child's home; is the most able to meet the identified needs of (3) the child; [and] (4) satisfies any expressed interests of the child relating to placement, when developmentally appropriate; and (5) is able to meet the long-term needs of the child,
