5	SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 11, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 3108 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 3108. GOVERNOR'S MEDAL OF SERVICE AWARD
8	Sec. 3108.001. GOVERNOR'S MEDAL OF SERVICE AWARD. (a) The
9	Governor's Medal of Service award may be awarded to a resident of
10	this state who:
11	(1) honorably retired from a position of public
12	service in state or local government;
13	(2) contributed to the residents of this state in an
14	extraordinary way through the individual's work in the private
15	sector; or
16	(3) contributed to the residents of this state in an
17	extraordinary way as a member of the Texas Legislature.
18	(b) The governor may, at the governor's discretion, award
19	not more than two Governor's Medal of Service awards each year.
20	Sec. 3108.002. GIFTS. The office of the governor may
21	solicit and accept gifts, grants, and donations from any public or
22	private source for any expenses related to the administration of
23	the Governor's Medal of Service award, including establishing the
24	award.
