3 (4) receives a substantial tangible benefit from the4 company or the department; or

5 (5) is an officer, employee, or consultant of an 6 association in the field of insurance.

SECTION 2. Section 2054.052(b), Insurance Code, as amended by this Act, does not affect the entitlement of a member serving on the board of directors of the Texas Mutual Insurance Company immediately before the effective date of this Act to continue to serve for the remainder of the member's term.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
