## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to the regulation of certain business entities that act as 2 3 data brokers. Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 509.001(4), Business & Commerce Code, as 5 6 added by Chapter 963 (S.B. 2105), Acts of the 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023, is amended to read as follows: 7 "Data broker" means a business entity that 8 (4) collects, processes, or transfers [whose principal source of 9 revenue is derived from the collecting, processing, or transferring 10 of] personal data that the business entity did not collect directly 11 12 from the individual linked or linkable to the data. 13 SECTION 2. Section 509.003(a), Business & Commerce Code, as added by Chapter 963 (S.B. 2105), Acts of the 88th Legislature, 14 Regular Session, 2023, is amended to read as follows: 15 Except as provided by Subsection (b), this chapter 16 (a) 17 applies only to a data broker that, in a 12-month period, derives: (1) more than 50 percent of the data broker's revenue 18 from processing or transferring personal data [that the data broker 19 did] not collected by the data broker [collect] directly from the 20 21 individuals to whom the data pertains; or 22 (2) revenue from processing or transferring the personal data of more than 50,000 individuals [that the data broker 23 24 did] not collected by the data broker [collect] directly from the

1 individuals to whom the data pertains.

2 SECTION 3. It is the intent of the 89th Legislature, Regular 3 Session, 2025, that the amendments made by this Act be harmonized 4 with another Act of the 89th Legislature, Regular Session, 2025, 5 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted 6 codes.

7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
