- 7 Regular Session, 2023, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), this chapter
- 9 applies only to a business entity [data broker] that, in a 12-month
- 10 period, derives:
- 11 (1) more than 50 percent of the business entity's [data
- 12 broker's revenue from processing or transferring personal data
- 13 that the <u>business entity</u> [data broker] did not collect directly
- 14 from the individuals to whom the data pertains; or
- 15 (2) revenue from processing or transferring the
- 16 personal data of more than 50,000 individuals that the business
- 17 entity [data broker] did not collect directly from the individuals
- 18 to whom the data pertains.
- 19 SECTION 2. It is the intent of the 89th Legislature, Regular
- 20 Session, 2025, that the amendments made by this Act to Section
- 21 509.003(a), Business & Commerce Code, as added by Chapter 963 (S.B.
- 22 2105), Acts of the 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023, be
- 23 harmonized with another Act of the 89th Legislature, Regular
- 24 Session, 2025, relating to nonsubstantive additions to and

- 1 corrections in enacted codes.
