5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 71, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 71.0354 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 71.0354. PROSECUTING ATTORNEY INFORMATION. (a) Ir
8	this section, "prosecuting attorney" means a county attorney,
9	district attorney, or criminal district attorney representing this
10	state in criminal matters before the district or other courts of the
11	county.
12	(b) Each prosecuting attorney shall report in the form and
13	manner prescribed by the council information on:
14	(1) the categories of criminal offenses prosecuted by
15	the prosecuting attorney and the number of criminal cases in each
16	category;
17	(2) the number of personnel employed by the
18	prosecuting attorney and whether that number is sufficient to
19	support the prosecutor's caseload;
20	(3) the number of times a defendant was released as
21	provided by Article 17.151, Code of Criminal Procedure; and
22	(4) the number of electronic notices submitted by the

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23 prosecuting attorney to a court as required by Article

17.027(a)(2), Code of Criminal Procedure.

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- 1 (c) In prescribing the information to be submitted and form
- 2 and manner of submission of the information under Subsection (b),
- 3 the council shall consult with:
- 4 (1) the Texas District and County Attorneys
- 5 Association; and
- 6 (2) other interested persons.
- 7 SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2026, the Texas
- 8 Judicial Council shall prescribe the information, and form and
- 9 manner of submission, a prosecuting attorney in this state is
- 10 required to report under Section 71.0354, Government Code, as added
- 11 by this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
