10	(1) beginning February 25 and ending at midnight on

12	(2) beginning April 16 and ending at midnight on April
13	<u>21;</u>
14	(3) beginning May 1 and ending at midnight on May 5;
15	(4) beginning the Wednesday before the last Monday in
16	May and ending at midnight on the last Monday in May;
17	(5) beginning June 24 and ending at midnight on July 4;
18	(6) beginning five days before the first day of Diwali
19	and ending at midnight on the last day of Diwali; and
20	(7) [(2)] beginning December 20 and ending at midnight
21	on January 1 of the following year[; and
22	[(3) beginning May 1 and ending at midnight on May 5 if
23	the fireworks are sold at a location that is not more than 100 miles
2/1	from the Toyac-Mexico border and that is in a county in which the
