5	SECTION 1. Chapter 211, Local Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Subchapter D to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER D. ENFORCEMENT
8	Sec. 211.101. ENFORCEMENT OF CHAPTER AGAINST MUNICIPALITY.
9	(a) A person affected or aggrieved by a municipality's violation
10	of this chapter may bring an action against the municipality for
11	mandamus or declaratory or injunctive relief.
12	(b) A municipality's governmental immunity from suit is
13	waived in regard to an action under this section.
14	(c) A court may award court costs and reasonable and
15	necessary attorney's fees to the prevailing party in an action
16	under this section.
17	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
