## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 61.0731 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 61.0731. WAIVER OF CERTAIN APPLICATION FEES; FREE
- 9 COLLEGE APPLICATION WEEK. (a) The board shall designate the second
- 10 <u>full week of October as Free College Application Week. During the</u>
- 11 designated week, the board shall permit individuals in this state
- 12 to apply to any institution of higher education for undergraduate
- 13 admission without paying an application fee.
- 14 (b) The board may adopt rules as necessary to implement
- 15 Subsection (a).
- SECTION 2. Section 61.0731, Education Code, as added by
- 17 this Act, applies beginning with the 2025-2026 academic year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
