A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the construction, expansion, or modification of certain

- 3 concrete plants under a standard permit.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 382.05195, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (f-1) and amending Subsection (k) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (f-1) This subsection applies only to a standard permit
- 9 issued under this section that authorizes the operation of a
- 10 concrete plant that performs wet batching, dry batching, or central
- 11 mixing, including a permanent, temporary, or specialty concrete
- 12 batch plant, as defined by the commission. If the commission amends
- 13 the standard permit, the commission may require each facility
- 14 operator authorized to begin new construction, expansion, or
- 15 modification of a facility under the former standard permit to
- 16 update the facility's plans for the new construction, expansion, or
- 17 modification in accordance with the amended standard permit if the
- 18 facility operator did not begin the construction, expansion, or
- 19 modification before the adoption of the amended permit.
- 20 (k) An application for <u>an authorization to use</u> [the issuance
- 21 of a standard permit issued under this section for a concrete plant
- 22 that performs wet batching, dry batching, or central mixing,
- 23 including a permanent, temporary, or specialty concrete batch
- 24 plant, as defined by the commission, must include a plot plan that

- 1 clearly shows:
- 2 (1) a distance scale;
- 3 (2) a north arrow;
- 4 (3) all property lines, emission points, buildings,
- 5 tanks, and process vessels and other process equipment in the area
- 6 in which the facility will be located;
- 7 (4) at least two benchmark locations in the area in
- 8 which the facility will be located; and
- 9 (5) if the permit requires a distance, setback, or
- 10 buffer from other property or structures as a condition of the
- 11 permit, whether the required distance or setback will be met.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 382.05198, Health and Safety Code, is
- 13 amended by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (d) to
- 14 read as follows:
- 15 (c) An application for <u>an authorization to use</u> [the issuance
- 16 of a standard permit issued under this section must include a plot
- 17 plan that meets the requirements of Section 382.05195(k).
- 18 (d) If the commission amends a standard permit issued under
- 19 this section, the commission may require each facility operator
- 20 authorized to begin new construction, expansion, or modification of
- 21 a facility under the former standard permit to update the
- 22 facility's plans for the new construction, expansion, or
- 23 modification in accordance with the amended standard permit if the
- 24 facility operator did not begin the construction, expansion, or
- 25 modification before the adoption of the amended permit.
- 26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
