- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. TEXAS LOTTERY COMMISSION. Section 467.002,
- 6 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 467.002. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The commission is
- 8 subject to review under Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset Act). Unless
- 9 continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the commission
- 10 is abolished and this chapter, Chapter 466 of this code, and Chapter
- 11 2001, Occupations Code, expire September 2 $[\frac{1}{2}]$, 2025.
- 12 SECTION 2. TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE. Section
- 13 492.012, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 492.012. SUNSET PROVISION. The Texas Board of Criminal
- 15 Justice and the Texas Department of Criminal Justice are subject to
- 16 Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as
- 17 provided by that chapter, the board and the department are
- 18 abolished September 2 $[\frac{1}{4}]$, 2025.
- 19 SECTION 3. TEXAS ETHICS COMMISSION. Section 571.022,
- 20 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 571.022. SUNSET PROVISION. The commission is subject
- 22 to review under Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset Act), but is not abolished
- 23 under that chapter. The commission shall be reviewed during the
- 24 periods in which state agencies abolished in 2025 [2013] and every

- 1 12th year after that year are reviewed.
- 2 SECTION 4. DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION RESOURCES. Section
- 3 2054.005, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 2054.005. SUNSET PROVISION. $[\frac{a}{a}]$ The Department of
- 5 Information Resources is subject to Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset Act).
- 6 Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the
- 7 department is abolished and this chapter expires September 2 [4],
- 8 2025.
- 9 SECTION 5. ANGELINA AND NECHES RIVER AUTHORITY. Section
- 10 8501.0015(a), Special District Local Laws Code, is amended to read
- 11 as follows:
- 12 (a) The authority is subject to review under Chapter 325,
- 13 Government Code (Texas Sunset Act), but may not be abolished under
- 14 that chapter. The review shall be conducted under Section 325.025,
- 15 Government Code, as if the authority were a state agency scheduled
- 16 to be abolished September $\underline{2}$ [$\frac{1}{2}$], 2025, and every 12th year after
- 17 that year.
- 18 SECTION 6. LOWER NECHES VALLEY AUTHORITY. Section
- 19 8504.0021(a), Special District Local Laws Code, is amended to read
- 20 as follows:
- 21 (a) The authority is subject to review under Chapter 325,
- 22 Government Code (Texas Sunset Act), but may not be abolished under
- 23 that chapter. The review shall be conducted under Section 325.025,
- 24 Government Code, as if the authority were a state agency scheduled
- 25 to be abolished September $\frac{2}{2}$ [$\frac{1}{2}$], 2025, and every 12th year after
- 26 that year.
- 27 SECTION 7. SABINE RIVER AUTHORITY OF TEXAS. Section 2A(a),

- 1 Chapter 110, Acts of the 51st Legislature, Regular Session, 1949,
- 2 is amended to read as follows:
- 3 (a) The district is subject to review under Chapter 325,
- 4 Government Code (Texas Sunset Act), but may not be abolished under
- 5 that chapter. The review shall be conducted under Section 325.025,
- 6 Government Code, as if the district were a state agency scheduled to
- 7 be abolished September 2 [1], 2025, and every 12th year after that
- 8 year.
- 9 SECTION 8. TRINITY RIVER AUTHORITY OF TEXAS. Section
- 10 1A(a), Chapter 518, Acts of the 54th Legislature, Regular Session,
- 11 1955, is amended to read as follows:
- 12 (a) The Authority is subject to review under Chapter 325,
- 13 Government Code (Texas Sunset Act), but may not be abolished under
- 14 that chapter. The review shall be conducted under Section 325.025,
- 15 Government Code, as if the Authority were a state agency scheduled
- 16 to be abolished September $\underline{2}$ [$\underline{4}$], 2025, and every 12th year after
- 17 that year.
- 18 SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 19 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 20 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 21 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 22 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
