## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to requiring foreign language credit opportunities for

3 students enrolled in study abroad components or programs offered by

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 51.313 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 51.313. STUDY ABROAD: FOREIGN LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY.
- 9 (a) In this section, "institution of higher education" has the
- 10 meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
- 11 (b) For the purpose of providing the opportunity for
- 12 students to gain proficiency in a foreign language, an institution
- 13 of higher education that, through any baccalaureate degree program,
- 14 offers a study abroad component or program in a location where a
- 15 language other than English is primarily spoken shall provide, in
- 16 accordance with rules adopted under Subsection (c), an option that
- 17 allows a student enrolled in the study abroad component or program
- 18 to earn foreign language credit as part of that component or
- 19 program.

- 20 <u>(c) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall</u>
- 21 adopt rules as necessary to implement this section, including rules

- 4 SECTION 2. Section 51.313, Education Code, as added by this
- 5 Act, applies beginning with the 2026-2027 academic year.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
