- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 51.313 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 51.313. STUDY ABROAD: FOREIGN LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY.
- 9 (a) In this section, "institution of higher education" and
- 10 "private or independent institution of higher education" have the
- 11 meanings assigned by Section 61.003.

- 12 (b) For the purpose of providing the opportunity for
- 13 students to gain proficiency in a foreign language, an institution
- 14 of higher education or a private or independent institution of
- 15 higher education that, through any baccalaureate degree program,
- offers a study abroad program in a location where a language other
- 17 than English is primarily spoken shall provide an option that
- 18 allows a student enrolled in the study abroad program to earn
- 19 foreign language credit as part of that program.
- 20 <u>(c) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board may</u>
- 21 establish procedures and adopt rules to implement this section.
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 51.313, Education Code, as added by this
- 23 Act, applies beginning with the 2025-2026 academic year.
- 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
