- 2 relating to the composition of the governing bodies of local mental
- 3 health authorities and reports available to the governing body
- 4 members.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 533.035, Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(f) Each local mental health authority shall:</u>
- 9 (1) prepare a monthly expense report detailing each
- 10 expenditure the local mental health authority made in the preceding
- 11 month; and
- 12 (2) make the report available in an electronic format
- 13 to each member of the governing body, including ex officio
- 14 nonvoting members.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 533.0351, Health and Safety Code, is
- 16 amended by amending Subsections (a), (b), (c), and (c-1) and adding
- 17 Subsections (a-1) and (c-2) to read as follows:
- 18 (a) Each $[\frac{1f-a}{a}]$ local mental health authority must have
- 19 [has] a governing body. The [, the] governing body must include:
- 20 (1) for a local authority that serves only one county,
- 21 the sheriff of the county [as an ex officio nonvoting member]; and
- (2) for a local authority that serves two or more
- 23 counties, two sheriffs chosen in accordance with Subsection (b),
- 24 one of whom may serve as an ex officio nonvoting member [members].

- 1 (a-1) At least one voting member of the governing body of a
- 2 local mental health authority must be a member of the public who:
- 3 (1) has experience in business or as an employee in a
- 4 corporate setting;
- 5 (2) has not served in a public elective office; and
- 6 (3) is appointed by the governing bodies of the local
- 7 authority's participating local agencies in accordance with
- 8 Chapter 534 or, if the local authority does not have a participating
- 9 local agency, the local authority's governing body.
- 10 (b) In selecting sheriffs to serve as members of the
- 11 governing body under Subsection (a)(2), a [A] local mental health
- 12 authority that serves two or more counties shall take the median
- 13 population size of each of those counties and choose:
- 14 (1) one sheriff of a county with a population above the
- 15 median population size to serve as a [an ex officio nonvoting]
- 16 member under Subsection (a); and
- 17 (2) one sheriff of a county with a population below the
- 18 median population size to serve as a [an ex officio nonvoting]
- 19 member under Subsection (a).
- 20 (c) A sheriff who is chosen to serve as a member of the
- 21 governing body of a local mental health authority in accordance
- 22 with this section may designate a representative to serve as a
- 23 member of the body in the sheriff's place as a [an ex officio
- 24 nonvoting] member under Subsection (a). Except as provided by
- 25 Subsection (c-1), for a local authority that serves two or more
- 26 counties, one sheriff or designated representative of the sheriff
- 27 may serve [a sheriff or representative of the sheriff serves] as an

- 1 ex officio nonvoting member under Subsection (a) for the duration
- 2 of the applicable sheriff's term in office.
- 3 (c-1) For a local mental health authority that serves two or
- 4 more counties, the [A] local [mental health] authority may rotate
- 5 the <u>position of sheriff who serves as an [positions of]</u> ex officio
- 6 nonvoting member [members as] chosen in accordance with Subsection
- 7 (b) among the other sheriffs of the counties served by the local
- 8 authority. A local authority shall consult with each sheriff of the
- 9 counties served by the local authority in rotating the position of
- 10 sheriff serving as an [positions of] ex officio nonvoting member
- 11 [members] under this subsection.
- 12 <u>(c-2)</u> A person employed by a local mental health authority
- 13 may not serve as a member of the authority's governing body.
- SECTION 3. Section 533.0351(e), Health and Safety Code, is
- 15 repealed.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
