3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 302, Labor Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 302.021 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 302.021. RURAL WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT. (a) The purpose
7	of this section is to enhance the employability, earnings, and
8	standard of living of the people living in rural communities of this
9	state, through job creation and expansion, education, and skills
10	training.
11	(b) The commission, in consultation with the Texas
12	Education Agency and the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board,
13	shall administer a rural workforce development program to support
14	measurable programs advancing college and career readiness, skill
15	development, and work experience opportunities, including:
16	(1) recruiting and retaining businesses for
17	high-wage, high-demand careers aligned to the commission's
18	regional labor market information under Section 302.002 and the
19	occupational shortage areas reported under Section 302.019;
20	(2) working with one or more institutions of higher
21	education, as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code, to support
22	attainment of the coordinating board's long-range master plan for
23	higher education developed under Section 61.051, Education Code,
24	and to ensure students cost-effectively attain degrees and

- 1 postsecondary credentials of value; and
- 2 (3) working with participating rural school districts
- 3 to attain or maintain the highest or second highest performance
- 4 rating category under Chapter 39, Education Code.
- 5 (c) The commission may award grants to local entities that
- 6 perform activities related to the purposes of this section.
- 7 (d) The commission may award grants for technical
- 8 assistance to one or more nonprofit organizations with experience
- 9 <u>in improving outcomes</u>, including students' college and career
- 10 outcomes, in rural communities in this state. The nonprofit
- 11 organization shall assist a rural community's alignment of
- 12 workforce, higher education, and education goals, including access
- 13 and attainment of postsecondary credentials and degrees.
- 14 (e) The commission may accept gifts, grants, and donations
- 15 from any public or private source for the purposes of the program
- 16 and shall administer the program using money appropriated to the
- 17 <u>commission or money received from other sources.</u>
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
