- 5 SECTION 1. Section 503.001, Business & Commerce Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (f) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Artificial intelligence" means the use of machine
- 10 <u>learning</u> and <u>related</u> technologies that use data to train
- 11 statistical models for the purpose of enabling computer systems to
- 12 perform tasks normally associated with human intelligence or
- 13 perception, including computer vision, speech or natural language
- 14 processing, and content generation.
- 15 (2) "Biometric [, "biometric] identifier" means a
- 16 retina or iris scan, fingerprint, voiceprint, or record of hand or
- 17 face geometry.
- 18 <u>(f) This section does not apply to artificial intelligence</u>
- 19 or related training, processing, or storage, unless performed for
- 20 the purpose of uniquely identifying a specific individual. If a
- 21 biometric identifier captured for the commercial purpose of
- 22 artificial intelligence is used for another and separate commercial
- 23 purpose, the person possessing the biometric identifier is subject
- 24 to this section's provisions for the possession and destruction of

- 1 <u>a biometric identifier and the associated penalties.</u>
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
