- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1467.054(a), Insurance Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Not later than the 90th day after the date an
- 8 out-of-network provider receives an initial payment for a health
- 9 <u>care or medical service or supply, an</u> [An] out-of-network provider
- 10 or a health benefit plan issuer or administrator may request
- 11 mandatory mediation under this subchapter.
- 12 SECTION 2. (a) The changes in law made by this Act apply
- 13 only to a dispute regarding charges for a health care or medical
- 14 service or supply provided on or after the effective date of this
- 15 Act.
- 16 (b) A dispute regarding charges for a health care or medical
- 17 service or supply provided before the effective date of this Act is
- 18 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 19 of this Act if mediation of the dispute under Subchapter B, Chapter
- 20 1467, Insurance Code, is requested on or before the 120th day after
- 21 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect
- 22 for that purpose.
- 23 (c) If mediation of a dispute under Subchapter B, Chapter
- 24 1467, Insurance Code, regarding charges for a health care or

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- 1 medical service or supply provided before the effective date of
- 2 this Act is not requested on or before the 120th day after the
- 3 effective date of this Act, the dispute is not eligible for
- 4 mediation under that subchapter.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
