13	(c)[(b)] Subject to Section 411.087 and consistent with the
14	public policy of this state, the Texas State Board of Pharmacy is

17	criminal history record information maintained or indexed by that
18	bureau that pertains to a person described by <u>Subsections</u>
19	[Subsection] (a) and (b); and
20	(2) obtain from the department or any other criminal
21	justice agency in this state criminal history record information
22	maintained by the department or that criminal justice agency that
23	relates to a person described by <u>Subsections</u> [Subsection] (a) <u>and</u>
24	<u>(b)</u> .
25	<u>(d)</u> [(c)] The Texas State Board of Pharmacy may not release or
26	disclose to any person criminal history record information obtained
27	from the Federal Bureau of Investigation under Subsection

1 (c)(1)[(b)(1)]. Criminal history record information obtained by 2 the Texas State Board of Pharmacy under Subsection (c)(2)[(b)(2)]3 may not be released or disclosed to any person except on court 4 order, with the written consent of the person who is the subject of 5 the criminal history record information, or as provided by 6 Subsection (e)[(d)].

7 <u>(e)</u>[(d)] The Texas State Board of Pharmacy is not prohibited 8 from disclosing criminal history record information obtained under 9 Subsection <u>(c)(2)</u>[(b)(2)] in a criminal proceeding or in a hearing 10 conducted by the Texas State Board of Pharmacy or the State Office 11 of Administrative Hearings.

12 <u>(f)</u>[(e)] The Texas State Board of Pharmacy shall destroy 13 criminal history record information obtained under this section 14 after a final determination is made in the matter for which the 15 information was obtained.

16 (g) The failure or refusal of an employee of or applicant to 17 the Texas State Board of Pharmacy to provide the following on 18 request constitutes good cause for dismissal or refusal to hire:

a complete set of fingerprints;

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(2) a true and complete name; or

21 (3) other information necessary for a law enforcement
 22 entity to obtain criminal history record information.

(h) In addition to the information required by Section
 559.003, Occupations Code, a license holder who previously has not
 submitted a complete set of fingerprints as part of an application
 for a license as listed in Subsection (a), shall submit to the Texas
 State Board of Pharmacy with the completed application for renewal

of a license to practice pharmacy a complete set of fingerprints.
 Failure to submit a complete set of fingerprints under this section
 may result in a suspension or refusal to renew the license by the
 Texas State Board of Pharmacy.

8 SECTION 10. Section 503.308, Occupations Code, is amended 9 by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

10 (a) The executive council <u>shall</u> [by rule may] provide for 11 the issuance of <u>an associate</u> [a temporary] license. Rules adopted 12 under this subsection must provide a time limit for the period <u>an</u> 13 <u>associate</u> [a temporary] license is valid.

(b) The executive council by rule may adopt a system under which <u>an associate</u> [a temporary] license may be issued to a person who: (1) meets all of the academic <u>and examination</u> requirements for licensing; and (2) enters into a supervisory agreement with a supervisor approved by the executive council.

19 SECTION 11. Section 1201.003, Occupations Code, is amended 20 by amending subsections (17), (22), (23), and (26) to read as 21 follows:

(17) "License holder" or "licensee" means a person
 <u>listed on a Manufactured Housing Division License application</u> who
 holds a department-issued license as a manufacturer, retailer,
 broker, salesperson, or installer.

 company, corporation, <u>or association</u>[, or other group, however]

1 organized]. 2 (23) "Related Person" means an [person] individual 3 who: 4 (A) directly participates in management or 5 policy decisions; and is designated by an entity and satisfies the 6 (B) 7 requirements of Sections 1201.104 and 1201.113 on behalf of the entity, if the entity is licensed or seeking licensure under this 8 9 chapter. (26) "Salesperson" means a person who, as an employee 10 [or agent] of a retailer or broker, sells or offers to sell 11 manufactured housing to a consumer. 12 SECTION 12. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025. 13
