A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to certain structures located near a National Wildlife
3	Refuge.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 26, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 26.005 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 26.005. NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION. (a) This section
8	applies only in a county that has a population of less than 500,000
9	and:
10	(1) that:
11	(A) borders the Gulf of Mexico; and
12	(B) contains a National Wildlife Refuge; or
13	(2) is adjacent to a county described by Subdivision
14	<u>(1).</u>
15	(b) A person may not construct a structure that is taller
16	than 500 feet unless the person provides notice to the department at
17	least 90 days before beginning construction of the structure.
18	(c) Notice under this section must give sufficient detail of
19	the structure for the department to reasonably evaluate its impact
20	on wildlife.
21	(d) Upon receiving notice under this section, the
22	department may evaluate the proposed structure. If the department
23	determines that construction of the structure or structures would
24	materially damage wildlife in this state, the department may, on or

- 1 before the 90th day after notice is filed, seek relief as provided
- 2 by this section to limit or enjoin construction.
- 3 (e) If the department takes no action on or before the 90th
- 4 day after notice is filed, the person may proceed with
- 5 construction.
- 6 (f) A district court of a county in which the structure is
- 7 proposed to be constructed may restrain and enjoin the person from
- 8 constructing the structure.
- 9 <u>(g)</u> The court may grant injunctive relief on application of
- 10 the department.
- 11 (h) The department is not required to post a bond when
- 12 seeking injunctive relief under this section.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
