1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to a local option election on the sale of alcoholic  
1-22 beverages in certain areas of a municipality and the local  
1-23 regulation of premises in those areas.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 251.742, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is  
1-26 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (i) to  
1-27 read as follows:

1-28 (b) This section applies only to a municipality that:

1-29 (1) has a population of 15,000 or more~~[+]~~ and

1-30 ~~[-2-]~~ is located in two counties one of which:

1-31 (A) has a population of 340,000 or more;

1-32 (B) contains a municipality in which at least 85  
1-33 percent of the county's population resides; and

1-34 (C) borders the Gulf of Mexico; or

1-35 (2) has a population of 240,000 or more and:

1-36 (A) is located in two or more counties; and

1-37 (B) borders a man-made lake that has a surface  
1-38 area of at least 20,000 acres.

1-39 (i) Subject to Chapter 211, Local Government Code, the  
1-40 governing body of the municipality may adopt zoning and land use  
1-41 regulations applicable to a premises that sells alcoholic beverages  
1-42 in the boundaries of a zone designated under this section.

1-43 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
