A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to motor fuel measuring, quality, and testing standards.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2310.001(a), Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Subdivisions (1-a) and (7-a) to read as follows:
- 6 (1-a) "ASTM" means ASTM International, formerly known
- 7 as the American Society for Testing and Materials.
- 8 (7-a) "NIST" means the National Institute of Standards
- 9 and Technology.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 2310.060(a-1), Occupations Code, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 (a-1) In implementing this section, the department or an
- 13 authorized representative of the department shall:
- 14 (1) follow the motor fuel quality testing standards
- 15 and procedures [adopted by the department] for collecting,
- 16 sampling, and handling motor fuel prescribed by Section 2310.203;
- 17 (2) obtain the approval of the executive director or
- 18 the executive director's designee before taking any action under
- 19 this section; and
- 20 (3) place a tag or other notice on each motor fuel
- 21 dispensing device subject to an order issued by the department
- 22 under this section.
- SECTION 3. Section 2310.107, Occupations Code, is amended
- 24 to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 2310.107. TOLERANCES. Specifications and tolerances
- 2 for motor fuel metering devices shall be the same as those adopted
- 3 in the most current edition of NIST Handbook 44 [recommended by the
- 4 Nationial Institute of Standards and Technology].
- 5 SECTION 4. Subchapter E, Chapter 2310, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 2310.2016 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2310.2016. MOTOR FUEL QUALITY STANDARDS. (a) The
- 8 minimum quality standards for motor fuel that is sold or offered for
- 9 sale in this state are the most recently adopted, nationally
- 10 recognized ASTM petroleum standards, including subsequent
- 11 <u>amendments and editions.</u>
- 12 (b) Except as provided in Section 2310.2031, gasoline or
- 13 gasoline blended with ethanol sold or offered for sale in Texas
- 14 shall conform with ASTM Designation D4814 for the applicable period
- 15 and region at all times.
- SECTION 5. The heading to Section 2310.203, Occupations
- 17 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 2310.203. [TESTING OF] MOTOR FUEL QUALITY TESTING
- 19 STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES.
- 20 SECTION 6. Section 2310.203(a), Occupations Code, is
- 21 amended to read as follows:
- 22 (a) The department or an authorized representative of the
- 23 department may collect samples and conduct testing at any location
- 24 where motor fuel is kept, transferred, sold, or offered for sale to
- 25 verify that the motor fuel complies with the fuel quality [minimum]
- 26 standards required by Section 2310.2016 [2310.202].
- 27 SECTION 7. Subchapter E. Chapter 2310, Occupations Code, is

- 1 amended by adding Section 2310.2031 to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 2310.2031. EXCEPTIONS TO MOTOR FUEL QUALITY STANDARDS.
- 3 (a) Gasoline or gasoline blended with ethanol sold or offered for
- 4 sale during periods when areas on either side of the 99-degree
- 5 longitude line have different volatility classes, as provided in
- 6 the ASTM Designation D4814 Schedule of U.S. Seasonal and Geographic
- 7 Volatility Classes, conforms with this chapter and commission rules
- 8 if it complies with the volatility class for either area.
- 9 (b) Gasoline sold or offered for sale that meets or exceeds
- 10 the Driveability Index prescribed by the ASTM Designation D4814
- 11 Vapor Pressure and Distillation Class Requirements for vapor
- 12 pressure/distillation classes AAA, AA, or A conforms with ASTM
- 13 standards, this chapter, and rules set by the commission.
- 14 (c) Gasoline blended with up to 15 volume percent ethanol is
- 15 granted a vapor pressure tolerance waiver of 1.0 pound per square
- 16 inch except for gasoline blends sold or offered for sale from May 1
- 17 through October 1 in counties of this state required to comply with
- 18 low emissions fuels.
- 19 (d) Seasonal specifications for vapor pressure may be
- 20 extended for a maximum period of 15 days to allow for the
- 21 distribution of old stocks. However, new stocks of a higher
- 22 volatility classification may not be offered for retail sale before
- 23 the effective date of the higher volatility classification.
- 24 <u>(e) The vapor-to-liquid ratio specification is waived for</u>
- 25 gasoline ethanol/blends.
- 26 SECTION 8. The following provisions of the Occupations Code
- 27 are repealed:

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               (1) Section 2310.202; and
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               (2) Section 2310.203(c-1).
          SECTION 9. A violation committed before the effective date
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   of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense
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   or violation was committed, and the former law is continued in
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   effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense or
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   violation was committed before the effective date of this Act if any
   element of the offense or violation was committed before that date.
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          SECTION 10. This Act takes effect immediately if
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   receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
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   house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
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   If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
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effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
