7	CHAPTER 121. DISCRIMINATION BY PROFESSIONAL OR TRADE ASSOCIATION
8	PROHIBITED
9	Sec. 121.001. DENIAL OF MEMBERSHIP OR SERVICES. (a) A
10	professional or trade association may not deny a person access to or
11	membership or participation in the association because of race,
12	color, religion, sex, disability, familial status, or national
13	origin or because of the person's exercise of the person's freedom
14	of speech or assembly, notwithstanding any provision of the
15	association's bylaws.
16	(b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), a professional or trade
17	association may deny a person access to or membership or
18	participation in the association because the person has engaged in
19	speech that:
20	(1) directly incites criminal activity;
21	(2) constitutes a specific threat of violence against
22	a person because of the person's race, color, disability status,
23	religion, familial status, national origin or ancestry, age, sex,
24	or status as a peace officer or judge; or

1	(3) otherwise constitutes unlawful speech.
2	(c) This chapter does not apply to a professional or trade
3	association whose membership or participation in the association is
4	exclusively based on race, color, religion, sex, disability,
5	familial status, or national origin.
6	Sec. 121.002. PRIVATE CAUSE OF ACTION. (a) A person
7	aggrieved by a violation of Section 121.001 may bring an action
8	against the professional or trade association for injunctive relief
9	or damages.
10	(b) The court may award court costs and reasonable
11	attorney's fees to the prevailing party in an action brought under
12	this section.
13	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
