BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 5, Business & Commerce Code, is amended by adding Chapter 121 to read as follows:

CHAPTER 121. DISCRIMINATION BY PROFESSIONAL OR TRADE ASSOCIATION

PROHIBITED

Sec. 121.001. DENIAL OF MEMBERSHIP OR SERVICES. professional or trade association may not deny a person access to or membership or participation in the association because of race, color, religion, sex, disability, familial status, or national origin or because of the person's exercise of the person's freedom speech or assembly, notwithstanding any provision of the

association's bylaws.

Sec. 121.002. PRIVATE CAUSE OF ACTION. (a) A person aggrieved by a violation of Section 121.001 may bring an action against the professional or trade association for injunctive relief or damages.

(h) The

<u>(b)</u> cour<u>t</u> 1-40 <u>aw</u>ard and court costs may reasonable 's fees to the prevailing party in an action brought under attorney's fe this section. 1-41 1-42

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
