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S.B. No. 2779

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the allocation and use of certain hotel occupancy tax 3 revenues.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 156.2511, Tax Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to 7 read as follows:

8 (a) Not later than the last day of the month following a 9 calendar quarter, the comptroller shall:

10 (1) compute the amount of revenue derived from the 11 collection of taxes imposed under this chapter at a rate of two 12 percent and received from hotels located in an eligible coastal 13 municipality that has created a park board of trustees to 14 administer public beaches under Chapter 306, Local Government Code; 15 and

16 (2) issue to the <u>park board of trustees created by the</u> 17 eligible coastal municipality a warrant drawn on the general 18 revenue fund in the amount computed under Subdivision (1).

(b) <u>Money</u> [An eligible coastal municipality may use money]
received under this section <u>may be used</u> only to clean and maintain
public beaches in <u>the eligible coastal</u> [that] municipality.

22 (b-1) The comptroller may issue a warrant under this section 23 only if the eligible coastal municipality has:

24 (1) allocated at least one percent of the tax imposed

| 9 | SECTION 2. Section 351.101, Tax Code, is amended by adding |
| 10 | Subsection (b-1) to read as follows: |
| 11 | (b-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), revenue derived from |
| 12 | the tax authorized by this chapter may not be expended in a manner |
| 13 | or by a program or activity that discriminates on the basis of race, |
| 14 | color, disability, sex, religion, age, or national origin. |
| 15 | SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025. |

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
