- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 30, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 7 Section 30.08 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 30.08. TRESPASS IN FACILITY HOUSING AN ANIMAL. (a) In
- 9 this section, "harass" means to engage in any act that:
- 10 (1) demonstrates a disregard for the well-being of an
- 11 animal; or
- 12 (2) disrupts the normal behavior patterns of an
- 13 animal, including disrupting the animal's feeding, watering,
- 14 <u>resting</u>, or breeding.
- 15 (b) A person commits an offense if the person enters an
- 16 indoor or outdoor facility housing an animal that is operated for
- 17 the purpose of public visitation, conservation, education, or
- 18 science, including a zoo, and the person:
- (1) enters a cage, enclosure, or other area where an
- 20 <u>animal is exhibited or housed; and</u>
- 21 (2) knows the person has no legal authority, license,
- 22 or permission to enter.
- (c) An offense under this section is a state jail felony,
- 24 except that the offense is a felony of the third degree if it is

- 1 shown on the trial of the offense that:
- 2 (1) the actor harassed the animal; and
- 3 (2) the animal suffered injury or death.
- 4 (d) It is a defense to prosecution under this section that
- 5 the person entered the cage, enclosure, or other area to aid another
- 6 person or an animal located in the cage, enclosure, or other area.
- 7 (e) It is not a defense to prosecution under this section
- 8 that:
- 9 <u>(1) entry to the cage, enclosure, or other area where</u>
- 10 the animal was exhibited or housed was not sufficiently guarded,
- 11 locked, or made otherwise inaccessible; or
- 12 (2) injury to the animal was necessary to protect the
- 13 person from injury or death.
- 14 SECTION 2. Article 42.037, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 15 amended by adding Subsection (y) to read as follows:
- 16 <u>(y) If a defendant is convicted of an offense under Section</u>
- 17 30.08, Penal Code, the court shall order the defendant to make
- 18 restitution to the facility for the cost of any damage, loss, or
- 19 destruction as a result of the offense, including the injury or
- 20 death of the animal.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
