- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 56, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 56.0094 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 56.0094. FINANCIAL AID DISPLACEMENT. (a) In this
- 8 section:

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- 9 (1) "Coordinating board" means the Texas Higher
- 10 Education Coordinating Board.

- 11 (2) "Gift aid" means a grant, scholarship, exemption,
- 12 waiver, or other financial aid awarded to a student without a
- 13 requirement to repay the aid or earn the aid through work.
- 14 (b) The coordinating board shall develop a financial aid
- 15 displacement advisory for use by institutions of higher education
- 16 under this section that contains:
- 17 (1) a statement bordered by a line one point in weight
- 18 in a font not less than 14 points in size in the following form:
- 19 "Financial aid displacement occurs when a student's
- 20 financial aid is reduced because of the receipt of a private
- 21 scholarship or for other reasons identified below. This practice
- 22 occurs in Texas, and the institution of higher education in which
- 23 you are enrolling is required, not later than the 30th day after
- 24 reducing your financial aid, to provide you notice of the financial

- 1 aid that has been reduced, the amount by which that aid has been
- 2 reduced, and why that aid has been reduced."; and
- 3 (2) a list of the reasons for which the amount of gift
- 4 aid a student is awarded might be revised or reduced under this
- 5 chapter.
- 6 (c) An institution of higher education shall send the
- 7 financial aid displacement advisory developed under Subsection (b)
- 8 to a student not later than the seventh day after the date on which
- 9 the student is admitted to the institution. The advisory may be
- 10 sent by text message, e-mail, or mail.
- 11 (d) Not earlier than the 30th day before or later than the
- 12 30th day after an institution of higher education revises or
- 13 reduces the amount of gift aid a student will receive under this
- 14 chapter for a school year, the institution shall send to the student
- 15 <u>a financial aid reduction notice identifying:</u>
- 16 (1) the gift aid that will be or has been revised or
- 17 reduced;
- 18 (2) the amount by which the gift aid will be or has
- 19 been revised or reduced; and
- 20 (3) the reason the gift aid will be or has been revised
- 21 or reduced.
- (e) An institution of higher education shall annually
- 23 report to the coordinating board in a manner provided by
- 24 coordinating board rule a report on the revision or reduction of
- 25 gift aid at the institution under this chapter during the preceding
- 26 academic year. The report must include the following information,
- 27 disaggregated by race and sex:

- 1 (1) the number of students whose gift aid was revised
- 2 or reduced;
- 3 (2) the average amount by which the gift aid was
- 4 revised or reduced; and
- 5 (3) the reasons the gift aid was revised or reduced.
- 6 (f) The coordinating board shall annually submit to the
- 7 legislature and post on the coordinating board's Internet website a
- 8 report on the revision or reduction of gift aid under this chapter
- 9 during the preceding academic year. The report must include the
- 10 following information, disaggregated by race and sex:
- 11 (1) the total number of students whose gift aid was
- 12 revised or reduced;
- 13 (2) the average amount by which the gift aid was
- 14 revised or reduced; and
- 15 (3) the three most common reasons the gift aid was
- 16 <u>revised or reduced.</u>
- 17 (g) The coordinating board shall adopt rules necessary to
- 18 implement this section.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 56.0094, Education Code, as added by
- 20 this Act, applies beginning with the 2025-2026 academic year.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
