AN ACT

Municipal Utility District No. 1 of Tarrant and Wise Counties;

2 relating to the powers and duties of the Far North Fort Worth

- 4 providing authority to establish defined areas and to impose a tax
- 5 and issue bonds.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws
- 8 Code, is amended by adding Subchapter B, Section 8011.055 to read as
- 9 follows:

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10 SUBCHAPTER B. POWERS AND DUTIES

- 11 Sec. 8011.055. AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH DEFINED AREAS OR
- 12 DESIGNATED PROPERTY. Notwithstanding the acreage requirement
- 13 under Section 54.801(a), Water Code, the district may establish and
- 14 maintain defined areas or designated property of the district as
- 15 provided by Subchapter J, Chapter 54, Water Code, including the
- 16 power to impose taxes and issue bonds in the defined area or
- 17 designated property, to pay for improvements, facilities, or
- 18 services that primarily benefit that area or property and do not
- 19 generally and directly benefit the district as a whole.
- 20 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a defined area may
- 21 <u>include a noncontiguous tract.</u>
- 22 SECTION 2. The Far North Fort Worth Municipal Utility
- 23 District No. 1 of Tarrant and Wise Counties retains all rights,
- 24 powers, privileges, authority, duties, and functions that it had

- 1 before the effective date of this Act.
- 2 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 3 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 4 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 5 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 6 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 7 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 8 Government Code.
- 9 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 10 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 11 Environmental Quality.
- 12 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 13 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 14 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 15 representatives within the required time.
- 16 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 17 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 18 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 19 and accomplished.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
