1 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 2 WHEREAS, Pflugerville boasts an expansive trail network that provides residents and visitors with ample opportunities for 3 4 exercise, recreation, and social connection; and WHEREAS, Currently, Pflugerville maintains 56 miles 5 6 public trails within its city limits as well as an additional 15.2 miles in its extraterritorial jurisdiction, totaling more than 71 7 8 miles of accessible paths; an analysis by city staff has found that Pflugerville has more public trails per capita than any other city 9 in the state, with 1.49 miles per 2,000 residents; moreover, an 10 estimated 94.8 percent of its citizens live within a half mile of a 11 12 trail, and 70 percent use the trails regularly; and 13 WHEREAS, Pflugerville's trail network meets robust safety 14 standards and features parking, lighting, and restrooms along major 15 routes, ensuring a safe and convenient experience for trail users of all ages; in addition to facilitating access to green spaces, the 16 trails serve as a hub for a wide variety of cultural activities, 17 including community events, recreational programming, and public 18 19 art installations; the pathways also help to reduce traffic congestion by connecting local neighborhoods, schools, 20 21 businesses; and 22 WHEREAS, The trail network in Pflugerville has made the city

a popular destination for Texans who enjoy active lifestyles, and
