1 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Texas School for the Deaf alumnus Robert Rives was a 3 dedicated educator and a trailblazing figure in the state's deaf 4 and hard of hearing community; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Rives became the first TSD alumnus to attend the 5 prestigious National College, which is today known as Gallaudet 6 University, in Washington, D.C.; following his graduation in 1893, 7 he embarked on a rewarding career as a teacher at TSD that spanned 8 more than four decades; he also served as the school's first 9 football coach from 1894 to 1898, achieving a record of 10-8-1; 10 among his many honors, he was inducted into the Texas School for the 11 Deaf Alumni Association Hall of Fame in the sports category in 1999; 12 13 and

14 WHEREAS, Robert Rives continues to be a source of inspiration 15 to young athletes at the Texas School for the Deaf, and the naming 16 of the TSD middle school gymnasium in his honor would be a fitting 17 tribute to his legacy; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas
19 hereby direct the Texas School for the Deaf to name its middle
20 school gymnasium the Robert Rives Gymnasium; and, be it further

21 RESOLVED, That the secretary of state forward an official 22 copy of this resolution to the Governing Board of the Texas School 23 for the Deaf.
