1 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 2 WHEREAS, An independent United States Supreme Court is an
- 3 essential element of America's system of checks and balances that
- 4 protects our constitutional rights; and
- 5 WHEREAS, For more than 150 years, the U.S. Supreme Court has
- 6 been composed of nine justices; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The president and Congress should be prohibited from
- 8 undermining the independence of the court by changing the number of
- 9 appointed justices; now, therefore, be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas
- 11 hereby respectfully urge the Congress of the United States to
- 12 propose and submit to the states for ratification the "Keep Nine"
- 13 amendment to the United States Constitution, stating that "The
- 14 Supreme Court of the United States shall be composed of nine
- 15 justices"; and, be it further
- RESOLVED, That the Texas secretary of state forward official
- 17 copies of this resolution to the president of the United States, to
- 18 the president of the Senate and the speaker of the House of
- 19 Representatives of the United States Congress, and to all the
- 20 members of the Texas delegation to Congress with the request that
- 21 this resolution be entered in the Congressional Record as a
- 22 memorial to the Congress of the United States of America.
