CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1           WHEREAS, The Town of Trophy Club has demonstrated an  
2 exceptional commitment to fostering patriotism among its  
3 citizenry; and

4           WHEREAS, In 1985, the year of its incorporation, Trophy Club  
5 raised the American flag at the intersection of State Highway 114  
6 and Trophy Club Drive; this location at the entrance to the town had  
7 hosted Independence Day celebrations carried out by local families  
8 since the early 1970s; today, the flag continues to fly at the site,  
9 a proud symbol of the town residents' love of country; Old Glory is  
10 also displayed daily at seven other civic spaces thanks to the  
11 efforts of the Trophy Club Fire Department, and every Fourth of  
12 July, the Stars & Stripes Committee places flags along every street  
13 in town; and

14           WHEREAS, Trophy Club originated as a small, golf-centric  
15 retreat that quickly became home to numerous Dallas-area executives  
16 and retirees; over the years, the master-planned town has grown  
17 into a lively residential community with more than 14,000  
18 residents; the population is deeply engaged in community-oriented  
19 activities, including school functions, church services, and the  
20 meetings of town advisory groups, clubs, and other organizations;  
21 local events such as the Medal of Honor Motorcade Celebration,  
22 Patriot Day Ceremony, and Memorial Day Ceremony are designed to  
23 bring people together, strengthen bonds, and encourage a spirit of  
24 service among citizens of all ages; and

1           WHEREAS, In 2014, Trophy Club adopted a logo that reflects  
2 the town's deep sense of patriotism, and its red, white, and blue  
3 design features a star as a key element; the town has given its  
4 public spaces such names as Independence Park, Freedom Dog Park,  
5 and Harmony Park, signaling a love of liberty and unity and a  
6 respect for those who have served in the nation's military;  
7 Veteran's Memorial Park, located on land donated by the town, was  
8 established by the Trophy Club Women's Club and is maintained by the  
9 town in association with the Metroport Veterans Association; other  
10 patriotic civic groups include the Honor Our Wounded Military  
11 Foundation and Trophy Club Rotary; and

12           WHEREAS, Since its inception, the Town of Trophy Club has set  
13 an inspiring example by making patriotism a centerpiece of  
14 community life and civic engagement, and its efforts deserve to be  
15 duly recognized; now, therefore, be it

16           RESOLVED, That the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas  
17 hereby designate the Town of Trophy Club as the official Texas Town  
18 of Patriotism; and, be it further

19           RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of  
20 Section 391.003(e), Government Code, this designation remain in  
21 effect until the 10th anniversary of the date this resolution is  
22 finally passed by the legislature.
