SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1-18 WHEREAS, The National Life Monument celebrates the miracle of 1-19 life and the women at the center of that miracle; and

1-20 WHEREAS, Sculpted by artist Timothy Schmalz, the bronze 1-21 sculpture depicts a mother with an unborn child cradled in a 1-22 world-shaped womb; and
