1-19 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1-20 WHEREAS, The life of Sergio Ivan Rodriguez was tragically cut
1-21 short on December 9, 2024, at the tender age of 15 in his hometown of
1-22 Houston, Texas; though his time was brief, Sergio left an indelible
1-23 mark on his family, friends, and community; and it is indeed fitting
1-24 to name a pedestrian bridge in his memory; and

1-25 WHEREAS, Born on March 2, 2009, Sergio was known for his
1-26 infectious sense of humor and his ability to bring joy to those
1-27 around him; a dedicated 10th-grade student at Charles H. Milby High
1-28 School, he was passionate about football and was admired for his
1-29 talent on the field, where he poured his heart into the game he
1-30 loved; and

1-31 WHEREAS, Sergio's enthusiasm extended beyond sports; he
1-32 cherished time spent with his family and friends, bonding over
1-33 shared interests such as movies, video games, and wings, his
1-34 favorite food; he had a special affection for his cats, Chana and
1-35 Rambo, and his love for animals further exemplified his kind and
1-36 compassionate spirit; and

1-37 WHEREAS, To honor the memory of Sergio Ivan Rodriguez and
1-38 recognize the joy and inspiration he brought to those around him, it
1-39 is fitting to commemorate his life in a way that reflects his
1-40 enduring spirit and love for his community; now, therefore, be it

1-41 RESOLVED, That the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas
1-42 hereby urge the Houston City Council to construct the Sergio Ivan
1-43 Rodriguez Memorial Pedestrian Bridge over the railroad tracks near
1-44 Charles H. Milby High School in honor of Sergio Ivan Rodriguez,
1-45 ensuring that his legacy of love, laughter, and dedication to his
1-46 family and his community will be remembered for generations to
1-47 come; and, be it further

1-48 RESOLVED, That the secretary of state forward an official
1-49 copy of this resolution to the Houston City Council.
