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## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The Panama Canal is a vital maritime passage that 3 facilitates trade and ensures the efficient movement of goods 4 between the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans; and

5 WHEREAS, The expansion of the Panama Canal has significantly 6 increased the volume of cargo passing through the waterway, 7 benefiting the shipping industry and the economies of the United 8 States and Texas; and

9 WHEREAS, The ports of Texas serve as critical hubs and are 10 directly impacted by the efficiency and security of the Panama 11 Canal; and

12 WHEREAS, Texas ports handle a substantial portion of U.S. 13 exports, including energy products such as liquefied natural gas 14 (LNG), crude oil, and refined petroleum, as well as agricultural 15 goods and manufactured products; and

16 WHEREAS, The economic prosperity of the State of Texas and 17 the broader United States depends on the continued free flow of 18 goods through the Panama Canal to support supply chains, trade 19 agreements, and domestic industries; and

20 WHEREAS, Ensuring the security and stability of the Panama 21 Canal is essential for maintaining U.S. national security 22 interests, preventing disruptions of trade, and countering foreign 23 influence in the region; and

24 WHEREAS, Investments in Texas ports, infrastructure, and

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trade partnerships reinforce the strategic position of the United
States as a global economic leader; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas 4 hereby recognize the strategic importance of the Panama Canal to 5 the economic strength of the United States and the State of Texas; 6 and, be it further

7 RESOLVED, That the Texas Legislature support continued 8 investment in Texas ports and infrastructure to maximize the 9 benefits of global trade and ensure long-term economic 10 competitiveness; and, be it further

11 RESOLVED, That the Texas Legislature urge the Trump 12 Administration to prioritize diplomatic engagement with Panama to 13 maintain the security, efficiency, and accessibility of the canal 14 for U.S. commerce; and, be it further

15 RESOLVED, That the Texas Legislature encourage policies that 16 enhance the ability of Texas industries to compete in global 17 markets through reliable and cost-effective shipping channels; 18 and, be it further

19 RESOLVED, That the Texas Legislature call for collaboration 20 between federal, state, and private sector stakeholders to 21 strengthen supply chain resilience and safeguard U.S. economic 22 interests; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Texas secretary of state forward official copies of this resolution to the president of the United States, to the president of the Senate and the speaker of the House of Representatives of the United States Congress, and to all the members of the Texas delegation to Congress with the request that

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this resolution be entered in the Congressional Record as a
memorial to the Congress of the United States of America.
