CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, House Bill No. 46 has been adopted by the house of
2 representatives and the senate and is being prepared for
3 enrollment; and

4 WHEREAS, The bill contains a technical error that should be
5 corrected; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED by the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas, That
7 the enrolling clerk of the house of representatives be instructed
8 to make the following corrections to the enrolled version of House
9 Bill No. 46:

10 In SECTION 16 of the bill, in added Section 169.006(b),
11 Occupations Code (page 11, lines 16-20), strike "Notwithstanding
12 any other provision of this chapter, low-THC cannabis prescribed
13 under Subsection (a) for pulmonary inhalation may exceed one
14 percent by weight of tetrahydrocannabinols in each dosage unit of
15 the substance to be aerosolized or vaporized.".
