A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the denial of bail
- 2 under limited circumstances to a person accused of certain violent
- 3 or sexual offenses or of continuous trafficking of persons.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article I, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 11d to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 11d. (a) A person accused of committing a sexual
- 8 offense punishable as a felony of the first degree, of committing a
- 9 violent offense, or of committing continuous trafficking of persons
- 10 may be denied bail pending trial if a judge or magistrate determines
- 11 by clear and convincing evidence after a hearing that requiring
- 12 bail and conditions of release is insufficient to reasonably
- 13 ensure:
- 14 (1) the person's appearance in court as required; or
- 15 (2) the safety of the community, law enforcement, or
- 16 the victim of the alleged offense.
- 17 (b) A judge or magistrate who denies a person bail in
- 18 accordance with this section shall prepare a written order that
- 19 <u>includes findings of fact and a statement explaining the judge's or</u>
- 20 magistrate's reason for the denial.
- 21 (c) This section may not be construed to:
- (1) limit any right a person has under other law to
- 23 contest a denial of bail or to contest the amount of bail set by a
- 24 judge or magistrate; or

- 1 (2) require any testimonial evidence before a judge or
- 2 magistrate makes a bail decision with respect to a person to whom
- 3 this section applies.
- 4 (d) For purposes of determining whether clear and
- 5 convincing evidence exists to deny a person bail as described by
- 6 this section, a judge or magistrate shall consider the factors
- 7 required to be considered by a judge or magistrate in setting bail
- 8 under general law, including statutory law governing criminal
- 9 procedure.
- 10 (e) In this section, "violent offense" and "sexual offense"
- 11 have the meanings assigned by Section 11a of this article.
- 12 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.
- 14 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 15 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the denial
- 16 of bail under limited circumstances to a person accused of certain
- 17 violent or sexual offenses or of continuous trafficking of
- 18 persons."
