A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment clarifying that a qualified
- 2 voter in this state must be a United States citizen.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2(a), Article VI, Texas Constitution, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) Only a [Every] person subject to none of the
- 7 disqualifications provided by Section 1 of this article or by a law
- 8 enacted under that section who is a citizen of the United States and
- 9 who is a resident of this state shall be deemed a qualified voter in
- 10 any election held in this state; provided, however, that before
- 11 offering to vote at an election a voter shall have registered, but
- 12 such requirement for registration shall not be considered a
- 13 qualification of a voter within the meaning of the term "qualified
- 14 voter" as used in any other Article of this Constitution in respect
- 15 to any matter except qualification and eligibility to vote at an
- 16 election.
- 17 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 18 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.
- 19 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 20 proposition: "The constitutional amendment clarifying that a
- 21 qualified voter in this state must be a United States citizen."
