A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the Kickapoo
- 2 Traditional Tribe of Texas to conduct gaming on certain lands under
- 3 state law; limiting certain taxes and fees.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 47(a), Article III, Texas Constitution,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The Legislature shall pass laws prohibiting lotteries
- 8 and gift enterprises in this State other than those authorized by
- 9 Subsections (b), (d), (d-1), and (e) of this section and Section 47a
- 10 of this article.
- 11 SECTION 2. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 12 adding Section 47a to read as follows:
- Sec. 47a. (a) If, after January 1, 2025, this state by
- 14 general law or constitutional amendment authorizes video lottery
- 15 terminals, slot machines, or other forms of gaming not otherwise
- 16 authorized before that date within 200 miles of the boundary of the
- 17 reservation of the Kickapoo Traditional Tribe of Texas near Eagle
- 18 Pass, Texas, the tribe is authorized to offer at a location the
- 19 tribe designates any game, device, or other form of gaming,
- 20 including any form of mobile gaming, authorized under that law or
- 21 <u>amendment</u>. The number of games or devices authorized at the
- 22 <u>designated location is equal to any maximum number of games or</u>
- 23 devices authorized under that law or amendment for other gaming
- 24 locations. The designated location must be on land in this state

- 1 owned or leased by the Kickapoo Traditional Tribe of Texas that is
- 2 outside the boundary of the tribe's reservation.
- 3 (b) The gaming authorized under this section shall be
- 4 regulated by the Kickapoo Traditional Tribe of Texas and the
- 5 Secretary of State. A rule on gaming conducted by the tribe that
- 6 this state adopts may not be more restrictive than a rule applicable
- 7 to other comparable types of gaming licensed by this state.
- 8 (c) A state or local tax rate or fee may not be imposed on
- 9 the tribe's gaming operations in an amount that exceeds the amount
- 10 of a tax rate or fee imposed on the operators of other gaming
- 11 locations or facilities in this state.
- 12 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.
- 14 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 15 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 16 Kickapoo Traditional Tribe of Texas to conduct gaming on certain
- 17 lands under state law."
