A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to designate subjects for legislation during a special session.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 40, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 40. (a) When the legislature is [Legislature shall be]
- 7 convened in a special session, the legislature may not consider
- 8 [there shall be no] legislation on a subject [upon subjects] other
- 9 than a subject [those] designated in the proclamation of the
- 10 governor [Governor] calling the [such] session, [or] presented to
- 11 the legislature [them] by the governor, or designated by either
- 12 house of the legislature by resolution approved by a two-thirds
- 13 vote of the members of that house. A subject designated by one
- 14 house of the legislature may be considered by the other house.
- 15 (b) No special [Governor; and no such] session shall be of
- 16 longer duration than thirty days.
- 17 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 18 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.
- 19 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 20 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 21 legislature to designate subjects for legislation during a special
- 22 session."
