# R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Deputy Jesus "Jesse" Vargas of the Brazoria County  
2 Sheriff's Office was killed in the line of duty on January 15, 2025,  
3 at the age of 41, and his untimely passing is a tragic loss to his  
4 family, to his fellow officers, and to the residents of his  
5 community; and

6 WHEREAS, Born on April 28, 1983, to Felix and Genoveva  
7 Vargas, Jesse Vargas grew up with the companionship of his seven  
8 siblings, Francisco, Guadalupe, Marisol, Felix, Eduardo, Benito,  
9 and Susanna; he went on to exchange wedding vows with Digna Emerita  
10 Bonilla, and the couple were blessed with three daughters,  
11 Josephine, Breanna, and Sofia; he was also a beloved uncle to many  
12 nieces and nephews; and

13 WHEREAS, As a 17-year veteran of law enforcement, Deputy  
14 Vargas dedicated his life to protecting and serving his community;  
15 he was a pillar of support to those around him, both on and off the  
16 job, and his compassion and devotion to duty left a lasting  
17 impression on his colleagues and fellow citizens alike; and

18 WHEREAS, Deputy Jesse Vargas was a courageous and caring law  
19 enforcement officer who embodied the highest ideals of his  
20 profession, and he will forever be remembered with admiration and  
21 affection by those he leaves behind; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the 89th Texas Legislature  
23 hereby pay tribute to the memory of Jesus "Jesse" Vargas and extend  
24 deepest condolences to all those who mourn his passing: to his wife,

2 Breanna Emerita Vargas, and Sofia Isabelle Vargas; to his parents,

5 Vargas Gamboa and her husband, Ruben, Felix Vargas Jr. and his wife,

7 wife, Crystal, and Susanna Cabrera and her husband, Luis; to his
