RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The University of Texas at Dallas has greatly 2 benefited from the visionary leadership of President Richard C. 3 Benson, who has guided the institution over the past eight years; 4 and

WHEREAS, In his role at UTD's helm, Dr. Benson has launched 5 ambitious fundraising endeavors, including the New Dimensions 6 7 campaign, which has amassed more than \$415 million to date; he has also overseen tens of millions of dollars in research expenditures, 8 and his tenure has coincided with the advancement of several 9 significant campus projects, including the opening of the Texas 10 11 Instruments Biomedical Engineering and Sciences Building and the 12 breaking of ground on the 12-acre Athenaeum cultural district; and

13 WHEREAS, Dr. Benson earned his bachelor's degree in aerospace 14 and mechanical science from Princeton University in 1973, his master's degree in mechanical engineering from the University of 15 16 Virginia in 1974, and his doctorate in mechanical engineering from the University of California, Berkeley, in 1977; prior to the start 17 of his career in higher education, he was employed with the Xerox 18 Corporation; in 1980, he became a professor of mechanical 19 20 engineering at the University of Rochester, where he later served 21 as an associate dean and chair of the Department of Mechanical 22 Engineering; and

23 WHEREAS, While at Penn State from 1995 to 2005, Dr. Benson 24 headed the Department of Mechanical Engineering, later renamed the

Department of Mechanical and Nuclear Engineering; he also served as
dean of the College of Engineering at Virginia Tech from 2005 to
2016, during which time that department achieved record growth; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Benson has been honored on many occasions by the American Society of Mechanical Engineers, of which he has been a Fellow since 1998; he received ASME's Henry Hess Award in 1984, and in 2009, he was elected to a three-year term on the organization's board of governors; he has further held editorial positions with several ASME publications, including its *Journal of Applied Mechanics*; and

11 WHEREAS, Throughout his tenure as president, Dr. Richard 12 Benson has worked tirelessly to elevate UTD's status as a 13 first-rate research university and a premier institution of higher 14 learning, and his achievements will continue to be appreciated for 15 many years to come; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the 89th Texas Legislature 17 hereby honor President Richard C. Benson for his outstanding 18 service to The University of Texas at Dallas and the field of higher 19 education and extend to him sincere best wishes for the future; and, 20 be it further
